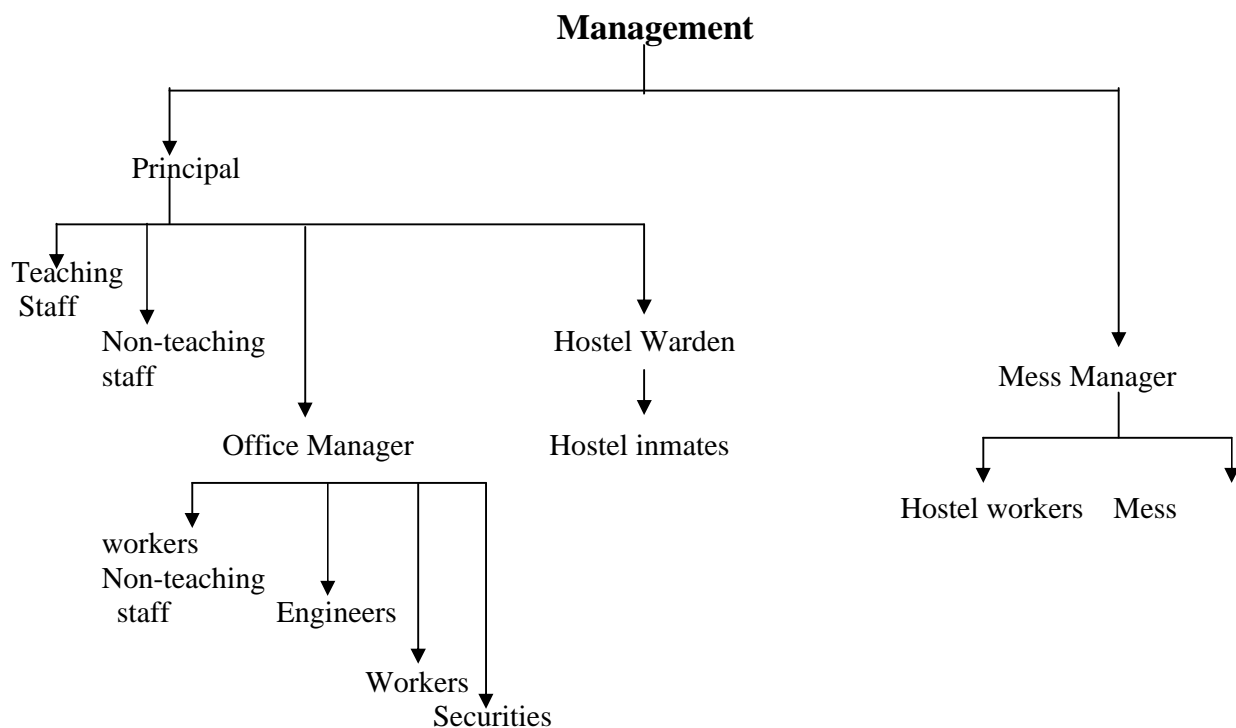

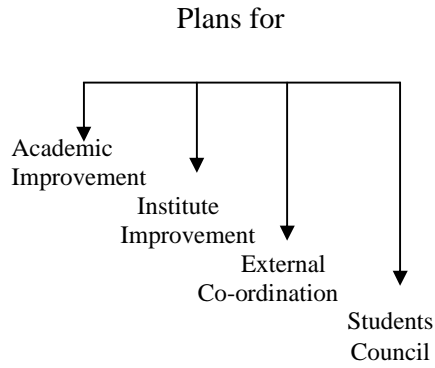
❖ Frequency of the Board Meetings and Academic Advisory Body

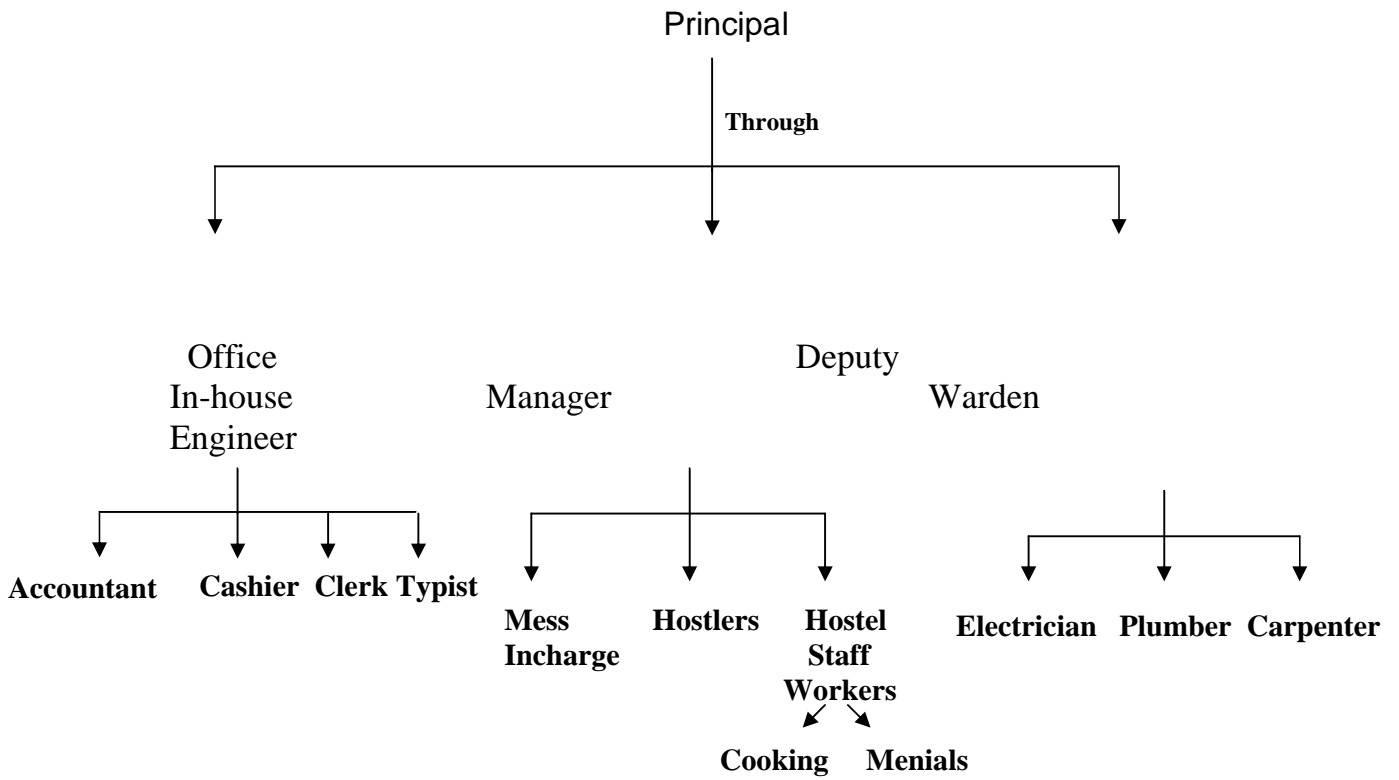
❖ Organizational chart and processes
